



MARINE SAFETY ACT 1998

APPROVAL OF CERTAIN PERSONS UNDER CLAUSE 47(b) OF THE *MARINE SAFETY (GENERAL) REGULATION 2009* TO DETERMINE INFORMATION ON AN AUSTRALIAN BUILDERS PLATE

APPROVAL

The Maritime Authority of NSW (Trading as "NSW Maritime"), does pursuant to Clause 47(b) of the *Marine Safety (General) Regulation 2009* (*the Regulation*) **APPROVE** the persons described in **SCHEDULE 1** as being persons authorised to determine and approve information on an Australian Builders Plate* fixed to, or to be fixed to, a vessel.

SCHEDULE 1

Description of Approved Persons

A "competent person", as defined by the National Marine Safety Committee, being a person who has acquired through training, qualification, experience or a combination of these, the knowledge and skills enabling that person to competently determine and approve the information on a builders plate such as a naval architect, marine surveyor, commercial boat builder or commercial boat designer.

*In this Instrument :

"*Australian Builders Plate*", means a plate fixed to a vessel displaying information about the vessel in accordance with the Standard entitled *National Standard for the Australian Builders Plate for Recreational Boats*, published under the authority of the Ministers comprising the Australian Transport Council, and as in force from time to time.


REVOCATION OF THIS APPROVAL
