



MARINE SAFETY (GENERAL) REGULATION 2009

ORDER EXEMPTING CERTAIN VESSELS FROM COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENT TO DISPLAY A TRADE PLATE

The Maritime Authority of NSW (Trading as "NSW Maritime"), pursuant to Clause 98(1) of the *Marine Safety (General) Regulation 2009* ("the Regulation") **HEREBY DIRECTS** that for the purposes of the Sydney International Boat Show 2011, the requirement (as a condition of being exempt from registration) for unregistered vessels in the charge of a 'trader', to display a 'trade plate' under clause 61(1)(f) of the *Marine Safety (General) Regulation 2009*, **DOES NOT APPLY** to the vessels described in SCHEDULE 1, provided that there is full compliance with each of the conditions set out in SCHEDULE 2

SCHEDULE 1 - VESSELS

This exemption applies to all vessels nominated by the Boating Industry Association of NSW (BIA) and listed on the BIA 'Marina Move-In' schedule for the Sydney International Boat Show 2011, such vessels being in the charge of a 'trader' - i.e. used for purposes connected with the manufacture, alteration, repair, testing, sale or demonstration for a commercial purpose.

SCHEDULE 2 CONDITIONS

In order for this exemption to apply, there must be full compliance with the following conditions by any trader operating an unregistered vessel:

- (a) The vessel must be operated only for the purposes of display during the Sydney International Boat Show 2011, or for direct transit between the event and the usual place of storage of the vessel in accordance with the BIA 'Marina Move-In' schedule;
- (b) The vessel must be operated in accordance with the times specified in the BIA 'Marina Move-In' schedule, or if that is not possible, as close to those times as practicable;
- (c) A copy of this exemption must be kept on board the vessel at all times;
- (d) The vessel must not exceed 30 knots;
- (e) The vessel must be operated by persons appropriately qualified.

IT IS NOTED THAT:

If any condition in Schedule 2 is not adhered to, this exemption ceases to apply and the operator of an unregistered vessel not displaying a trade plate may be guilty of an offence contrary to section 51 of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*.


REVOCATION

This exemption may be revoked at any time by the Chief Executive of NSW Maritime or the General Manager, Maritime Operations Division, NSW Maritime or their Delegates.

DATE OF EFFECT AND EXPIRY

This exemption is effective until sunset on 2 August 2011, unless revoked earlier by NSW Maritime.
