- The **Environment Medal** is directed at a person or group who performs an outstanding and sustained effort that benefits the environment for the boating and/ or maritime community of NSW.
- The **Community Medal** is directed at a person or group who performs an outstanding and sustained effort that benefits the general boating and/ or maritime community of NSW.
